Students in private lessons are guaranteed **two** make-up sessions. Make- ups will be held throughout the year or in May, depending on the instructor's availability.

Private Piano/Guitar Lessons with Ms. Kim

Guitar is for students age 6 and up.

If your child was registered in the fall and you have submitted your second payment, your child's spot will automatically be held. Children do not need to be registered again. We are only opening spots that are not already filled.

Early Childhood and Kindergarten lessons will take place at the Lower Campus. Lower Elementary, Upper Elementary, and Middle School lessons will take place at the Upper Campus.

Private instrument lessons (piano, guitar) are available for beginner to intermediate students. We employ a creative mix of teaching tools to provide our students with basic techniques unique to the particular instrument and fundamental musicianship skills. We also strive to strengthen hand-eye coordination, kinesthetic awareness, individual playing style, memorization skills and above all, to foster a love of music.

Private Music Lessons with Ms. Lauren

If your child was registered in the fall and you have submitted your second payment, your child's spot will automatically be held. Children do not need to be registered again. We are only opening spots that are not already filled.

All of Ms. Lauren's lessons will take place at the Lower Campus and are intended for Early Childhood and Kindergarten students only.

For these lessons, families can choose a variety of instruments to pursue! Our piano lessons teach basic techniques and note reading through engaging, hands-on activities. These lessons foster creativity and fine-motor skills, making piano learning a joyful experience. In our guitar lessons, children will explore the fundamentals of playing the guitar through hands-on, play-based activities. Ukulele lessons offer a fun and accessible introduction to string instruments. Percussion lessons are all about rhythm and beat. Children will explore a variety of percussion instruments, from drums to shakers, in a playful and exploratory environment. In our drum lessons, children will experience the excitement of playing the drums in a supportive, child-centered setting. Finally, the Multi-Sensory Sound Experience is a unique program that integrates

sound, music, and sensory play. No matter which instrument your child plays, we will use a Montessori-based approach that focuses on child-led exploration, open play, and hands-on learning, ensuring that each child can develop their musical abilities in a supportive and nurturing environment.

Private Piano/Voice Lessons with Mr. Robert: 30-minute lessons

All of Mr. Robert's lessons will take place at the Upper Campus and are intended for Lower Elementary, Upper Elementary, and Middle School students only.

Music instruction with Rob Stephens is based on the principle that inspiration and intellectual curiosity leads to creativity. Weekly individual instruction is available in piano and voice. Private coaching is also available for audition preparation. Through guided learning, students are encouraged to use music as a vehicle for both expression and self-discipline. Students are exposed to a broad spectrum of traditional and non-traditional musical styles from European classical music to world music (and many things in between), culminating in a recital at the end of the school year.
